Italy has historically championed vaccination policies

- One of the first European countries to experiment with smallpox, polio and acellular Pertussis vaccines
- First introduced universal vaccination against hepatitis B virus in 1991 and against HPV in 2007
- Flourishing R&D
- Consolidated tradition of extensive active and free of charge immunization offers, supported by the I-NHS

SUSPENSION OF MANDATORY VACCINATIONS IN VENETO REGION (2007)




An appealing policy



- In 2007 the Veneto Region (4mil.residents) suspended the obligation and invested in educational and information campaigns to better counteract the spreading of antivaccination movements
- This nudge theory didn't meet the ambitious goals
- Greater coverage decrease in Veneto than in other Regions

A STRENGTHENED POLITICAL COMMITMENT (2014-)



A concerted action

- A strong political committment, since 2014, has positively influenced scientists, journalists, judges about the utility of vaccinations
- The overall results were considered positive: new National Plan, new actions, increased coverage rates









Influenza coverage rates in the elderly (1999-2018)





The Italian "strong" policy (2017) or the "stopgap" to raise the vaccine uptake

- Mandatory vaccinations from 4 to 10
- Certificates at pre-school admission
- Fines (500€) for noncompliance
- Reinforce of information
- Sanctions to anti-vax MD




Emilia Romagna coverage rates for Polio and Measles (2011-2018*)
